

Important notice for course selection (spring 2023)

1. Course information can be checked in the course catalog system.

The system will be updated frequently in accordance with the change of course schedule.

2. Course selection period for spring 2023: Dec 23, 2022 to Jan 3, 2023.

Online course selection can be processed via course selection system.

3. Preliminary Course Registration Period : Dec 23, to Dec 26, 2022.

You can temporarily register for every course offered by your department; however, senior students cannot select courses offered for junior students, and undergraduates cannot select courses offered for postgraduates.

If the number of pre-register students exceeds the class limit, the system will process a random assignment later. Please check your course list on **Dec 29, 2022** for the result. If the course you previously registered is missing, it means you have not been chosen for that class. You may add other courses with available vacancies from **Dec 30, 2022 to Jan 3, 2023**.

4. Students need to confirm their required courses which are added by the system for spring 2023.

If there are any errors or questions, please contact the staff of Office of Academic Affairs.

5. Relevant guidelines for course selection

Please confirm whether the required courses are added to your course list by the system.

※If those courses are not on your course list, please add the course by yourself.

※If you cannot add the required course, please contact both Curriculum Development Section and your department for more information about course selection regulations and graduation requirements.

Required courses will not be added by the system for the following students.

(1) students returning from leave of absence

(4) 5th / 6th year undergraduates

(2) spring semester entrants

(5) students upgraded to a higher grade

(3) transfer students

(6) inter-disciplinary Bachelor's program students

※Please contact your department for more information for graduation requirements and add the courses online by yourself. (An authorization code is required from the instructor if the class is full.)

Please avoid dropping the required course unless it's necessary, except that the time of the required course overlaps with another course.

※If the required course can't be added later on, students are responsible for the consequence.

※In accordance with NTUST school regulations, students are not allowed to select timetable conflict courses (which means two courses open at the same time); otherwise, both courses will not be eligible for graduate requirements. (This also applies to authorization code selection operation. For more details, please check the regulations for course selection and school regulations.)

Double minor and double major (except for inter-disciplinary Bachelor's program entrants after 2018) students could add professional courses without the limitation of selecting courses offered by their own class.

Students are not allowed to take a course with the same title again.

※If students have taken and passed certain courses, or have transferred credits of those courses, those courses can't be selected again; otherwise, the same courses will not be recognized for graduate requirements

- 6. Only courses offered by your major department are available via online course selection system during preliminary course registration period.**
- 7. Intensive courses can be dropped before 2/18 of the teaching hours; however, they cannot be dropped via second course withdrawal.**
- 8. Master's or doctoral students who are going to graduate in midterm should not take any courses. The courses taken will be cancelled after they complete the graduation leaving procedure.**
- 9. Senior students are not allowed to select courses offered for junior students.**

Print out the application form, and send it before the designated deadline to the Registrar Section/Graduate Studies, Academic Affairs Office. ● For undergraduate students, after they drop courses, the total credit number should not be lower than required semester required credits. However, undergraduates who are in their last year or those with extended school years have to take at least one subject. ● The paid credit fees are not refundable. The courses that dropped will be marked as "W"(withdrawn) on the transcript. ● Intensive courses cannot be dropped via 2nd course withdrawal.
